MESA — Clara Goodman, 85, a retired pharmacist and widow of former Mesa mayor George Goodman, died Feb. 8, 1984, at her residence, 528 N. Grand St.

Mrs. Goodman was born in St. Johns and attended Safford schools. She was a graduate of Tempe Normal School and attended pharmacy school in California.

Mrs. Goodman was one of the first presidents of the Arizona Pharmaceutical Association auxiliary. She and her late husband formerly owned the Apache Drugstore in Mesa. Mr. Goodman, who served as mayor for 12 years and on the city council for 20 years, died in 1959.

Survivors include her daughters, Sue Pomeroy and Sherrie Pew; son, Harold; a sister; 21 grandchildren and 37 great-grandchildren.
